I. GRADES AND GRADING SCALE

A. Grades are based on a point system:

II. CHAPTER TESTS

- A. Neatness may affect your score, I will not try to decipher poor writing.
- B. Spelling is important
- C. Make-up tests <u>may be essay</u> in nature. It will <u>not</u> be to your advantage to miss class on the day of an exam. (School functions can be an exception if arranged).
- D. If a student misses the day before a previously announced test, he/she will be expected to take the test on the announced day!
- E. No talking during the testing period.

III. ABSENCES, TARDIES AND MAKE-UP WORK

- B. Unless otherwise stated, papers will be due at the beginning of the class.
- C 20% of the points possible will be deducted from late papers each day.

 No late papers will be accepted after the chapter test has been taken.
- D. Grades will be posted by textbook number or print-outs.
- E. All work is to be done by the individual student.
- F. Have your Chromebook and other materials with you when you come to class, I'm not a loaning service.
- G. Terms are to be done in complete sentences.
